UM POUCO DE MICHAEL JACKSON

- Michael Joseph Jackson was an American singer, songwriter and dancer. Nicknamed the "King of Pop", he was one of the most important and influential cultural icons of all time and one of the greatest artists in the history of music.
- The eighth child of the Jackson family, Michael made his professional debut in 1964, with his older brothers, Jackie, Tito, Jermaine and Marlon, as a member of the musical group The Jackson 5. He began his solo career in 1971, on Motown Records, and rose to solo stardom with Off the Wall (1979), which received critical acclaim.
- In 2009, while preparing for the This Is It tour, Jackson died from an overdose of sedatives administered by his personal doctor, Conrad Murray. (50 years)

MOMENTO HISTÓRICO - USA FOR AFRICA

- On an early morning in 1984, one of the most iconic events in music history took place. On January 28 of that year, 51 artists came together to record the song 'We Are the World'. The aim was to draw attention to hunger on the African continent and raise funds.
- With this in mind, Michael Jackson and Lionel Richie were responsible for writing the song. Determined to help the cause, they spent a week working not only on the lyrics, but also on the melody of the song that would become an anthem.

- Michael had vitiligo, a skin disease that affects the cells responsible for producing melanin.



- The revelation of the disease drew attention to vitiligo, which until then had been little known. Michael also expressed his indignation at speculation about his condition.

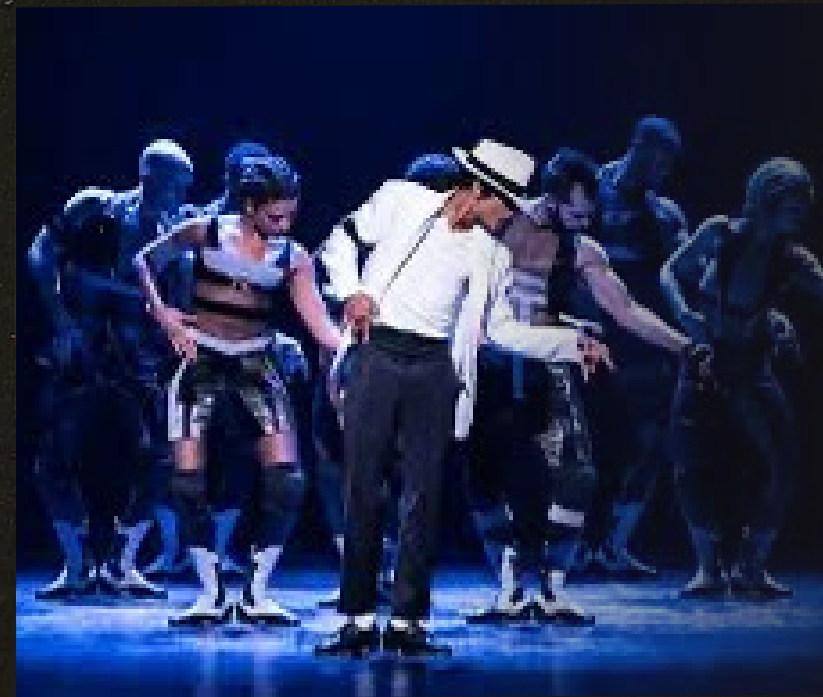

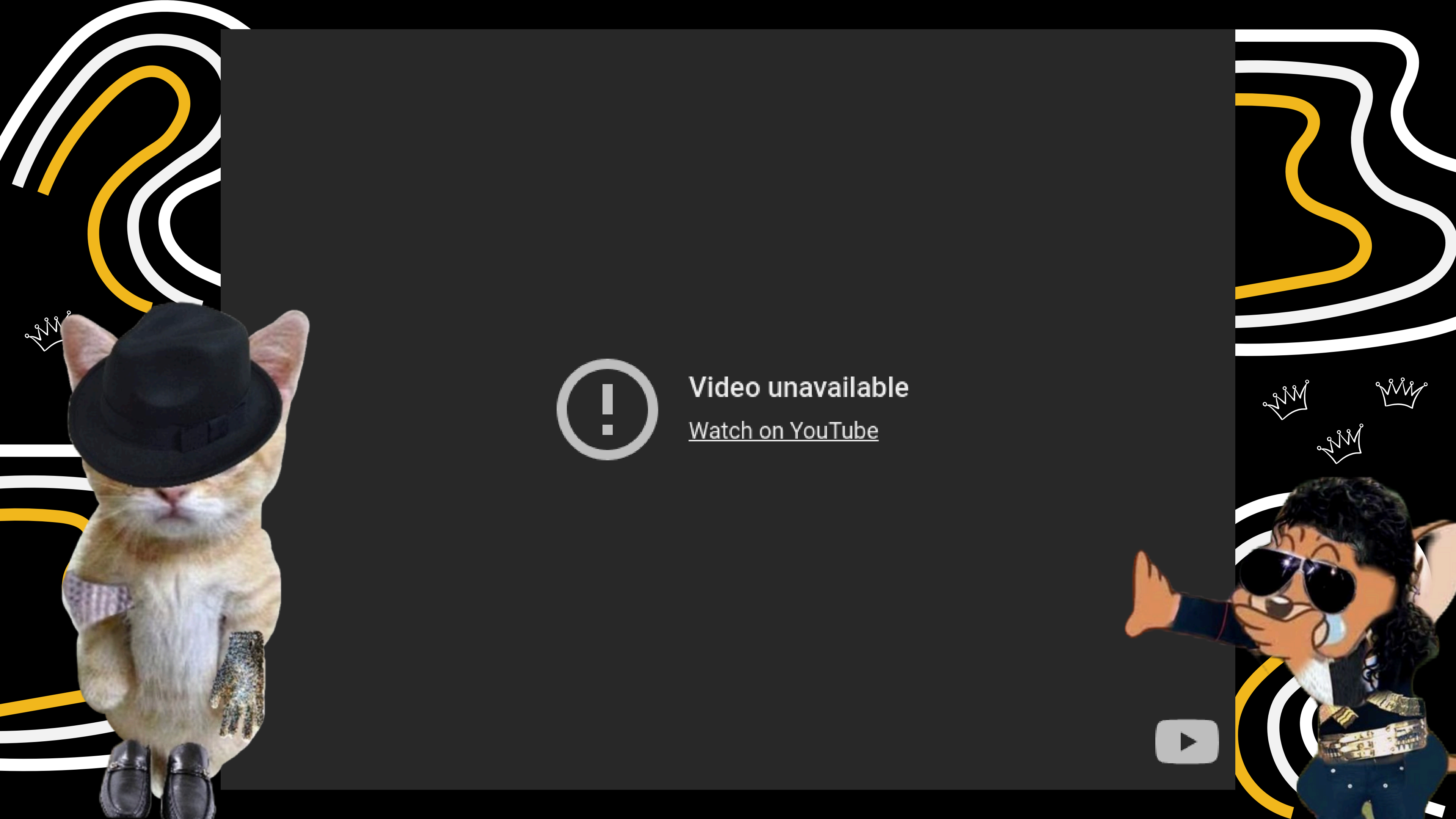

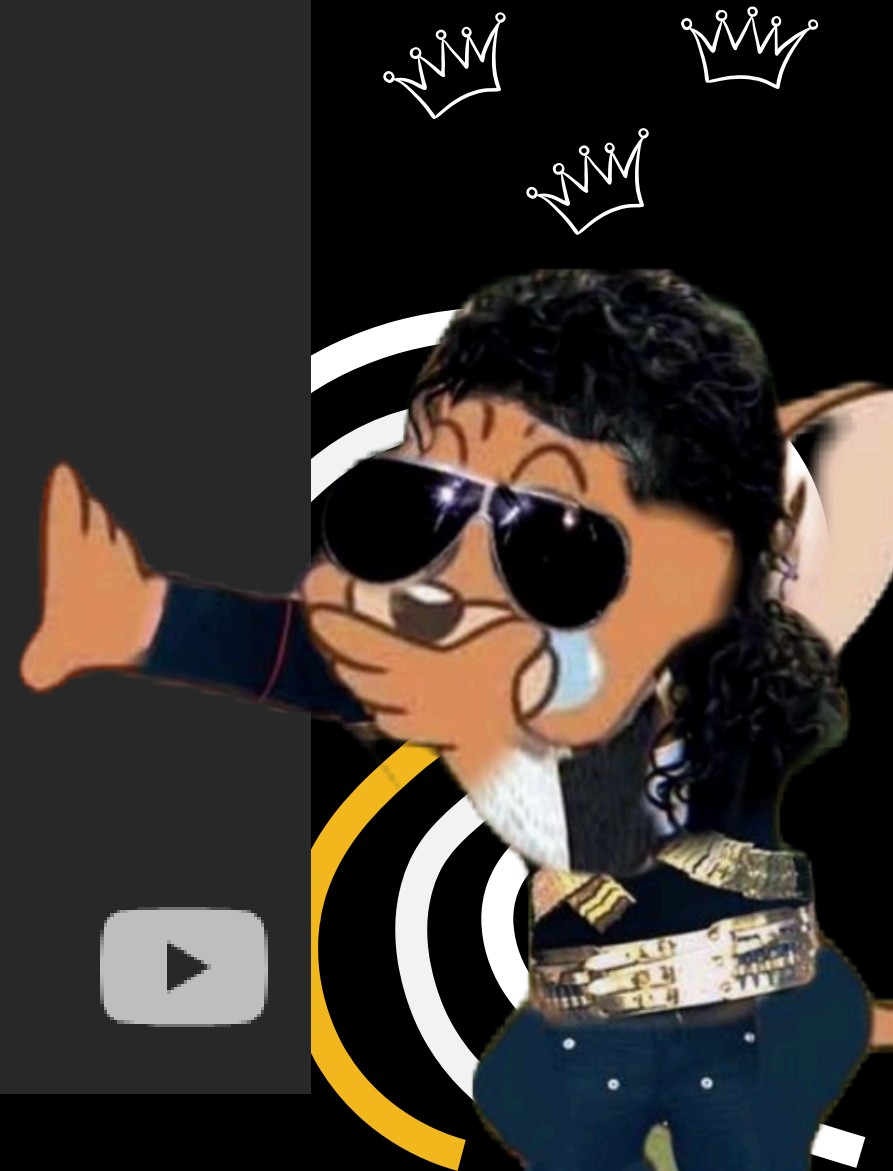
