- **Michael Jackson was born on August 29, 1958, in Gary, Indiana.**

(Michael Jackson nasceu em 29 de agosto de 1958, em Gary, Indiana.)

- **He began his career with his brothers in "The Jackson 5."**

(Ele começou sua carreira com seus irmãos no "The Jackson 5".)

- **In 1982, he released "Thriller", the best-selling album of all time.**

(Em 1982, ele lançou "Thriller", o álbum mais vendido de todos os tempos.)

- He became the "King of Pop" through his music, dance, and iconic style.

(Ele se tornou o "Rei do Pop" por meio de sua música, dança e estilo icônico.)

- Michael's humanitarian efforts earned him global admiration.

“MOONWALK”

- **First performed in 1983 during “Billie Jean”.**
(Apresentado pela primeira vez em 1983 durante “Billie Jean”.)
- **Became Michael Jackson’s signature move.**
(Tornou-se a marca registrada de Michael Jackson.)
- **Iconic dance move that seems to defy gravity.**
(Movimento icônico que parece desafiar a gravidade.)
- **Revolutionized dance and influenced pop culture.**
(Revolucionou a dança e influenciou a cultura pop.)
- **Established Michael as the “King of Pop”**
(Consolidou Michael como o “Rei do Pop”).

“ANTI-GRAVITY LEAN”

- **The famous move in Smooth Criminal is called the “Anti-Gravity Lean”.**
(O movimento famoso em Smooth Criminal é chamado de “Anti-Gravity Lean” (Inclinação Antigravidade).)
- **Michael and the dancers tilt their bodies forward at an impossible angle.**
(Michael e os dançarinos inclinam seus corpos para frente em um ângulo impossível.)
- **It appears to defy the laws of physics.**
(Parece desafiar as leis da física.)
- **The move was achieved using specially designed shoes.**
(O movimento foi realizado com sapatos especialmente projetados.)
- **It also required incredible strength and balance.**
(Também exigia força e equilíbrio incríveis.)

- **Breaking barriers on MTV:** Primeiro artista negro a ganhar destaque na MTV

- **The video was filmed in Brazil, showing local communities in Salvador and Rio de Janeiro.**






