- **Experimentation and Innovation:** Rihanna is known for taking risks and exploring new musical territories.

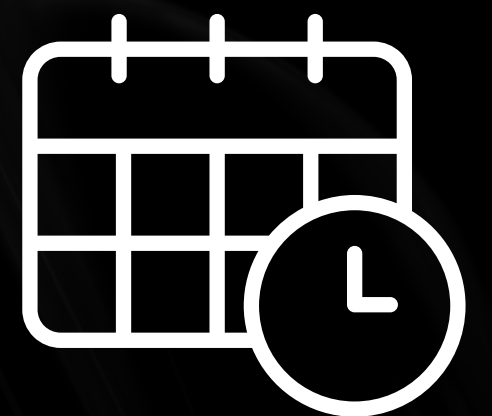

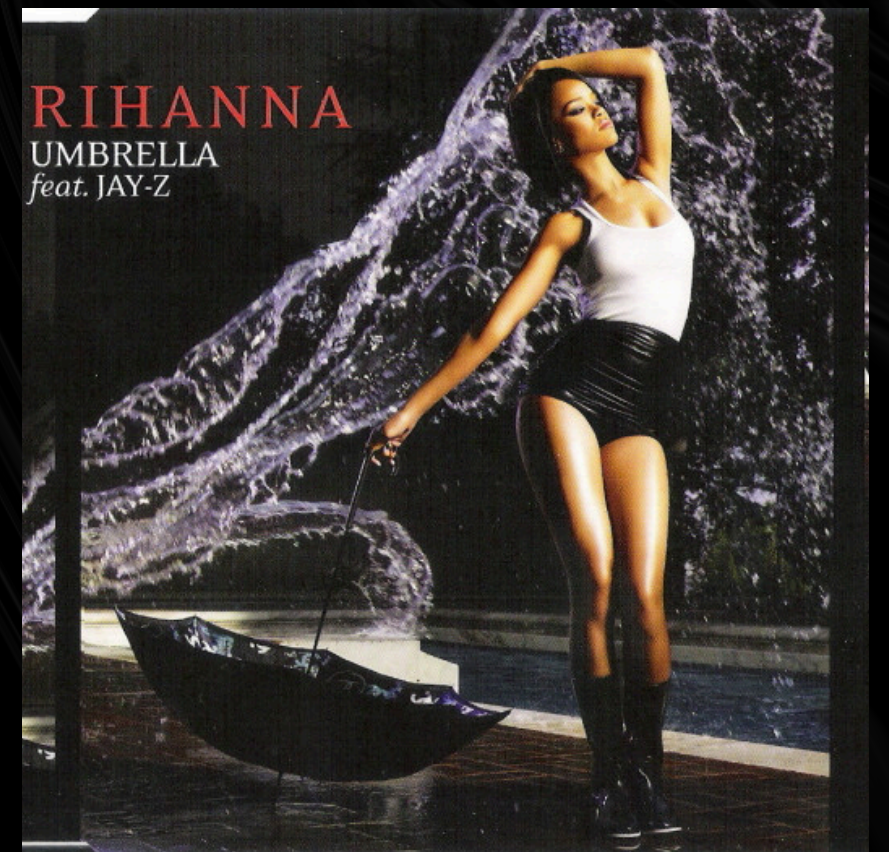
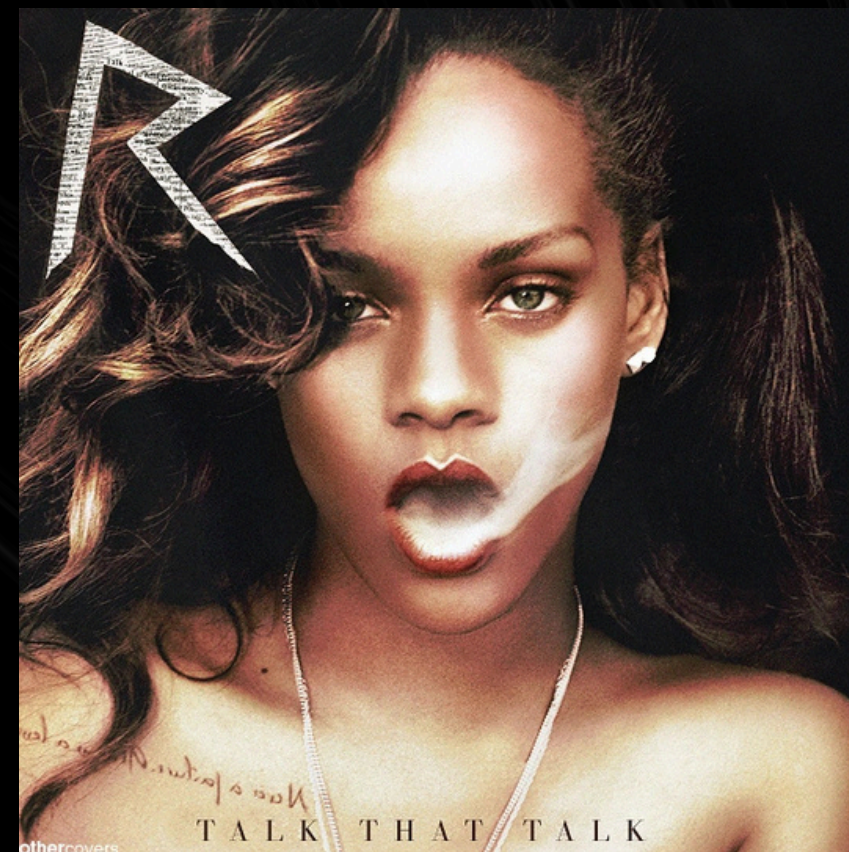
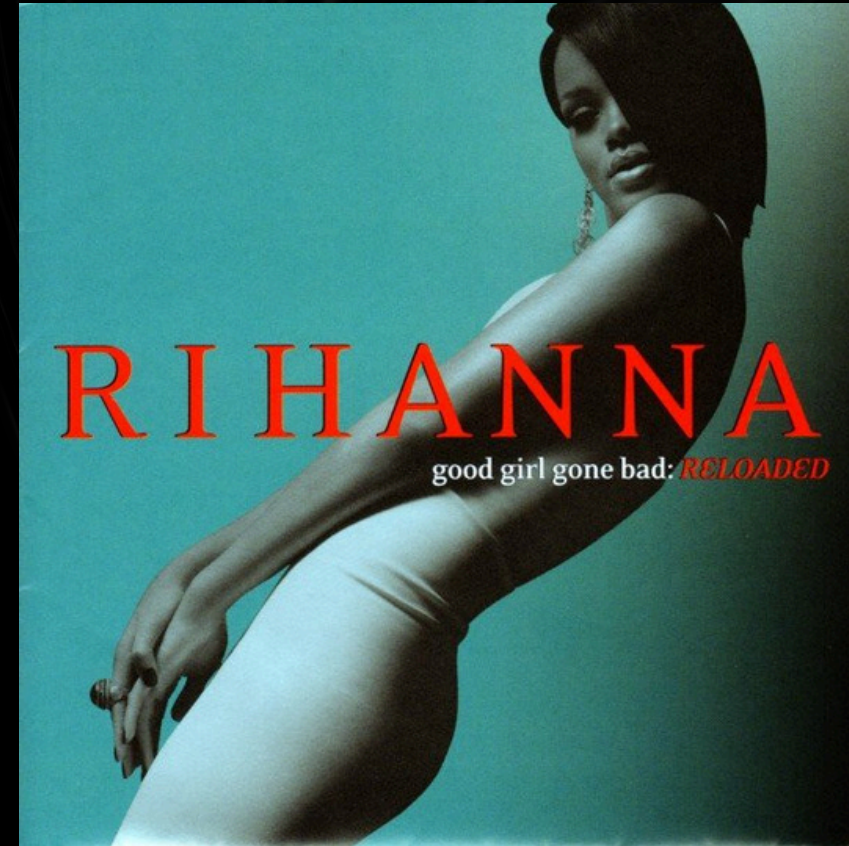
- **First iPhone Announced:** Apple revolutionized technology by introducing the iphone
