church's gospel choir at age
11.

She was influenced by her
musically talented family.

She is the daughter of Cissy
Houston, a renowned gospel
singer.

She worked as a backing
vocalist for famous artists
throughout her teenage years.

- Released her debut album, Whitney Houston, in 1985.
- Hit singles such as "Saving All My Love for You" and "Greatest Love of All" became global hits.
- Recognized by Guinness World Records as the most awarded female artist of all time.
- Debuted as an actress in The Bodyguard (1992), starring alongside Kevin Costner.
- His style was a mix of pop, R&B, soul and gospel.



- She was a pioneer in music, breaking racial barriers and influencing generations of artists.
- Whitney Houston's songs capture deep human emotions such as love, perseverance, strength and self-confidence.



- Whitney Houston performed at the Freedom Fest, a concert that celebrated the end of apartheid in South Africa and the election of Nelson Mandela as president.
- As a result, she dedicated several performances to Mandela, becoming an active defender of civil rights and freedom..
- The singer passed away on February 11, 2012, in Beverly Hills, California.
