#### **Ordinal numbers:**

1º/1a - First (exceto 11th) 21st, 601st;

2º/2ª - Second (exceto 12th) 32nd; 132nd;

3°/3° - Thi<u>rd</u> (exceto 13th) 83rd; 563rd;

Do 4° em diante th, incluindo 0:

4th (fouth), 15th (fifteenth), 20th (twentieth) etc.

**Obs:** No caso dos números que são **TY** o **Y** vira **IE** a acrescentarmos **TH.** 

Acima de 21 a gente escreve a primeira parte cardinal e a outra parte ordinal:

**35th** – (thirty-**fifth**); 23rd (Twenty-**third**); etc.
